The Forbidden City, also known as the Imperial Palace, was the residence of 24 emperors during the Ming and Qing dynasties. This palatial complex of 72 hectares contains 980 buildings and represents the quintessence of traditional Chinese architecture.	47
22 Nov 2025	Beijing	Today visit the Great Wall with cable car - Section Mutianyu. (With snacks (snickers & potato chips) and unlimited bottled water on the bus)  Service duration: 6-7 hours approximately.  • Mutianyu Great Wall is one of the best-preserved sections of the Great Wall and considered by many to be the most beautiful, being less crowded than tourist sections like Badaling. We include round-trip cable car tickets to facilitate access.	84
	<b>Timing</b>	8:30-10:30, Transfer from Hotel to Mutianyu Great Wall  10:30-11:00, Take shuttle bus to enter the Great Wall  11:00-11:30, Cable car to Tower 14 (our guide will be with the guest to Tower 14).  <i>Note 1: We quoted the entry ticket and roundtrip cable car, if guests want to take toboggan they can decide and pay on site</i>  <i>Note 2: if nobody takes toboggan, the meeting point will be at Tower 14 to go down together</i>  <i>Note 3: if some guests take toboggan, the meeting point will be at toboggan exit, next to it, it is the public bathroom and Mutianyu Map (before going up, guide will make instruction there)</i>  13:30-14:30, take the shuttle bus back to the exit and 30 minutes free time at the commercial street  15:00-17:00, transfer back to hotel  <b>All the timings are for reference only and may change due to traffic conditions or others.</b>	

\* The prices are net rate in USD and non-commissionable.

\* Services, rooms, and rates are subject to availability at the time of booking.

\* All accommodations booked through China a la Carte include daily breakfast and all taxes.

\* Hotel check-in: after 15:00 // Hotel check-out: before 12:00.

\* Cancellation/changes insurance for services and accommodation in China: 5% of the total value of the trip:

*If this insurance is taken and the clients, for whatever reason, decide to cancel the booked services through China a la Carte when cancellation fees are already applicable, we will proceed with a 90% refund of the costs. If the cancellation is made 48 hours or less before the service, this insurance will not be valid and the cancellation fee will be 100% anyways.*

\* **Luggage:** Our vehicle has capacity for one large piece of luggage and one piece of hand luggage per passenger. If it's a group of 5-9 pax, some of the back seats will be used due to the limited space in the trunk. If the passengers don't want any piece of luggage on the back seats, please let us know so we can quote an extra vehicle for luggage.

### The Price Includes:

- **All vehicles** that China a la Carta contracts are in mint condition and have all the necessary permits and insurance for tourism-related purposes.
- Official and experienced **tour guides**, speaking in the following language and with good command of the language:
- **Entrance fees** to the touristic attractions as described in the itinerary. We include general admission tickets (there might be some optional paying zones inside of some of the attractions, not included).
- All the **transfers** hotel/airport are with tour guide assistance.
- **Air tickets & train tickets** as mentioned in the itinerary.
- **Lunch & dinner** as mentioned in the itinerary.
- **24-hour Emergency** telephone line (English service).
- **Local insurance** and all permits necessary by law (customers have to get their own travel insurance).
- **Tips** may be offered to guides and / or chauffeurs at the discretion of the customer. Tips are welcome and appreciated.

### The Price Does Not Include:

- Assistance with hotel or service bookings that have not been made through China a la Carta.
- Tourist shops (\*) with no real interest.
- Any items not expressly detailed in the section "The price includes."

*(\*)Tourist shop refers to establishments where tourists are taken solely to pressure them to buy various products (silk, pearls, etc.) and where both the local agency and tour guide receive commission. We don't engage in this practice. However, in tourist attraction areas, there are many small shops that customers will encounter where neither the agency nor the tour guide receives any type of commission.*

In case a confirmed activity or service cannot be carried out as confirmed due to circumstances beyond our control, we will make every effort to reschedule or offer equivalent services. If this is not possible, a refund for the unused portion of services will not be offered.

### Domestic flights

Between some cities in China there are no direct flights, and sometimes we will book two different flights to connect these two cities. In this case, we will issue two independent flight tickets, and if the first plane is delayed or cancelled and it is not possible to board the second one, the cost of this second flight will not be reimbursed, and a new ticket will have to be bought by the customer.

### Exchange rate

The quotation has been calculated in Chinese currency (CNY or RMB) and converted into USD, as per the exchange rate shown at [www.xe.com/ucc](http://www.xe.com/ucc) on the day that the quotation was sent. China a la Carta reserves the right to change the price of the trip if the RMB exchange varies by more than 5% up to 1 month before departure.

### Availability and terms of payment for booking the services

This quotation has been made without confirming availability of quoted services. As soon as the agency accepts the quotation, China a la Carta will confirm the availability of the services (hotels, guides, flights, etc.) and will send a confirmation document and invoice for an amount of 30% of the total cost. The pending 70% must be paid 30 days before departure. If the trip is confirmed 30 days or less prior to arrival, the total 100% should be paid at once. Two methods of payment are available: bank transfer to our Chinese bank account or credit card payment (4.5% bank fees apply). If the trip is confirmed 7 days or less before arrival, the only valid method of payment will be credit card.

### Cancellation policy for groups of less than 10 pax

China a la Carta encourages all clients to purchase a cancellation insurance policy that will cover them in case of full or partial cancellations of our services.

Our cancellation policy for total cancellations is:

- Cancellations received 31 days or more before departure: any cancellation fee that airlines apply in case of cancellation of tickets issued or any other expense duly justified.
- Cancellations received between 15 and 30 days before departure: penalty of 50% of the total cost of trip.
- Cancellations received 2 weeks or less before departure: penalty of the total cost of trip.
- For partial cancellations like reducing the number of pax or cancelling a few services: please inquire.
- Modifying the dates for a trip (even using the same hotels and other services) will be considered as a cancellation and new booking — cancellation policy will apply.
- No refund will be issued if a customer does not wish to use any of the agreed services.

### **Cancellation policy for groups of more than 11 pax**

China a la Carta encourages all clients to purchase a cancellation insurance policy that will cover them in case of full or partial cancellations of our services.

For ground services (all services excluding hotel and flights), our cancellation policy for total cancellations is:

- Cancellations received 31 days or more before departure: any cancellation fee that airlines apply in case of cancellation of tickets issued or any other expense duly justified.
- Cancellations received between 15 and 30 days before departure: penalty of 50% of the total cost of trip.
- Cancellations received 2 weeks or less before departure: penalty of the total cost of trip.
- For partial cancellations like reducing the number of pax or cancelling a few services: please inquire.
- Modifying the dates for a trip (even using the same hotels and other services) will be considered as a cancellation and new booking — cancellation policy will apply.
- No refund will be issued if a customer does not wish to use any of the agreed services.

**For hotels and domestic flights**, the cancellation policy varies greatly from case to case. Please ask for specific details if needed.

### **Visas**

In order to visit China, you must have a visa which must be processed before leaving your country of origin at any Consulate or Embassy of China. The processing of this visa must be done by the customer/agency, and China a la Carta can only assist by providing an official service confirmation of the services (that is usually requested by the Chinese authorities). Tourist visas can be granted for 1 or 2 entries, and each time you enter Chinese territory, you must have 1 entry that has not been used. Hong Kong, in terms of immigration, is not considered China. As an example, doing the itinerary Shanghai, Hong Kong, and Beijing in this order would require a visa with 2 entries. For further information, we recommend contacting any Chinese Embassy or Consulate in your country.
